

On February 11, 2021, the Ministry of Children, Community, and Social Services (MCCSS) updated their directives around activity restrictions to correspond with the colour-coded system adopted by Ontario Public Health. To determine the colour code of your local Public Health Unit, please follow this <u>link</u>.

MCCSS has directed that support locations will follow "Enhanced Measures" based on the public health zone they are in. The MCCSS precaution levels are in addition to the public health measures that would be in place.

This document further clarifies situations unique to Christian Horizons employees and what should be done based on the public health zone their place of work is located in.

<ul> <li>An essential visitor is generally a person who:</li> <li>1. Performs essential services to support the ongoing operation of a service agency (including a contractor); and/or</li> <li>2. Considered necessary to maintain the health, wellness and safety, or any applicable legal rights, of a congregate living resident.</li> <li>An essential visitor may include but is not limited to the following: <ul> <li>A parent/guardian</li> <li>Social service workers (e.g., child welfare workers, day program operators etc.)</li> <li>Health care providers (e.g., doctor, nurse, personal)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>						Essential visitors who meet the requirements for visitation in outbreak/ comprehensive conditions must wear full PPE required for outbreak conditions.
